

#### Goldfields Car Club Run to Beeac Pub and publican's car collection

Sunday 26th May 2024

On a glorious autumn day, we gathered at Strides Greyhound carpark for the usual chat and admiring glances at our fancy cars before joining the leisurely one-hour cruise to Beeac.

In the function room at the back of the Beeac Pub 30 of us ordered drinks to start while perusing the menu of a mixture of pub classics and more modern creations. While we waited for our meals to be prepared, including the generous complimentary cheesy garlic bread, we were treated to a display and history of the stunning collection of just 10 of Ean McDowell's amazing vehicles.

They ranged from a Billie cart and Vespa to a couple of Rileys and an ASA Ferrari, designed specifically by Enzo Ferrari himself as an everyday small car. The plan was to build 3,000 but they were apparently too expensive for the American market, and they made only 119 - that final #119 is now housed in Ean's shed. Also on display was a Bugatti open wheel racer and a Formula Junior, a 4-cylinder "baby Ferrari" as Ean calls it, complete with his name sign written on it.

He purchased at least two of his vehicles internationally; one each from Barcelona and Paris and owns approximately 70 vehicles in total!

My favourite, aside from the Vespa similar to what I got my motorcycle licence on many years ago, was the 2-tone black and metallic blue 1953 Lancia Appia Series 1. She had lovely curves!

Even the shed itself is of historic value, being the original stables of the pub, resurrected by Ean and his wife Dorothy, who runs the kitchen. They took over the Beeac Pub in 2012 and celebrated its centenary in May 2014 following a makeover.

After lunch several of us who obviously hadn't eaten enough of their very generous meals, rolled ourselves down to the corner lolly shop, previously a draper's store, for another very generous serving of yummy ice cream. Also available is a huge selection of some 400 different types of lollies, ranging from gobstoppers to bananas and even one million dollar note bars of chocolate! Some members wandered across the road to the windmill park, created to honour the six windmill makers who called Beeac home from the 1890s to the 1940s. There's half a dozen or so old windmills, standing tall together, the breeze bringing to life the creak and rattle of each as they turn slowly.

The sunshine and blue sky remained for the drive back to Ballarat and a lovely day was had by all. Many thanks to Bill & Judy Loader for organising! Jodi.


# THE BIG RED GUM, RIVER RUN
